

Bring out your old pics

LAST week's Great Ocean Road 80th anniversary celebrations have set the scene for a new heritage centre in Lorne, according to Surf Coast Shire mayor Libby Coker.

The shire is now seeking community input as it strives to design the Great Ocean Road National Heritage Centre to explain how the road was built.

Cr Coker said the consul-

tation process would start early next year, and those keen to be involved should contact the shire's Tourism Marketing and Development Team.

"People can also support the centres development by contributing memorabilia for exhibition. The Lorne Historical Society recently issued a call for photographs, film footage, documents, stories and other

items relating to the roads construction and the Lorne of yesteryear," Cr Coker said.

The heritage centre will be located beside the busy Lorne Visitor Information Centre.
